#### **OUR THOROUGHLY MODERN TEENS—HELPING OTHERS**

Sometimes in order to adopt the true nature of a character onstage, an actor will elect to change something of their personal appearance. To create the characters from 1922, members of the cast of "Thoroughly Modern Millie, Jr." opted to have their hair styled according to the period. For some, that meant drastic cutting to adhere to the styles of the "moderns" of the age.

With these newly bobbed hairdos, the girls, along with several supporters and friends, were able to donate to "Children with Hair Loss". CWHL is an organization that was founded in September of 2000 to assist families and children cope with the hair loss associated with cancer. Since their inception, CWHL has expanded their capabilities to also provide hair replacement to children dealing with hair loss due to Alopecia, burns, Trichotillomania and other rare diseases and disorders. Unlike other similar organizations, CWHL has dedicated their resources to providing replacement and care kits at NO COST to the families who have need of them.

By donating their hair, all of them able to donate over eight inches as the organization asks, these cast members have supported the South Rockwood, MI, nonprofit organization in their mission to empower children during an emotionally, and financially, trying time. We will be selling coupons at "Velveteen Rabbit" & "Millie" as well as any time the box office is open.


